Islam was revealed to protect the natural rights of all human beings, their inalienable rights to life, property, and freedom. One reason we should be fearful of committing oppression is that Allah will **always** answer the supplication of an oppressed person. Abu Huraira reported: The Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, said: The supplications of three persons are never turned away:

- a fasting person until he breaks his fast,
- a just ruler,
- and the supplication of the oppressed which is raised by Allah above the clouds, the gates of heaven are opened for it, and the Lord says: By my might, I will help you in due time. (Sunan al-Tirmidhi 3598)
