In fact, this has been clearly mentioned in a Hadith related by Thawban (may Allah be pleased with him) that the Messenger of Allah (Allah bless him & give him peace) said: "Fasting Ramadhan is like fasting ten months, and fasting the six days is like fasting two months, so that amounts to fasting the entire year." (Recorded by Imam Ahmad in his *Musnad*, Ibn Hibban in his *Sahih* and Imam Nasa'i in his *Sunan*, taken from Ibn Rajab's *Lata'if* 272) So, in order to receive this specific reward of fasting the entire year, one would have to fast the whole month of Ramadhan (regardless of whether it consists of 29 or 30 days), and then follow it up with fasting the six days of Shawwal. For this reason, we see in the Hadith recorded by Muslim (quoted above) that the Messenger of Allah (Allah bless him & give him peace) said: "Whoever fasts Ramadhan, then follows it with..." i.e. one would need to first complete the fasts of Ramadhan before fasting the six days of Shawwal to attain this particular reward.
